EXTENSIONS OF SICK PAY

Purpose of Report

- 1.** To inform Members of the decisions taken by the Chief Fire Officer following consultation with the Chairman in respect of the granting of extensions of sick pay.

Background

- 2.** Since the Executive Panel's meeting on 15th November 2007, four extensions of sick pay have been granted.
- 3.** In one case the entitlement to six months full pay had expired followed by a further six months of pay at 100% of full pay. An extension of pay at 100% of full pay has been granted for a period of six months while treatment is progressing.
- 4.** In one case the entitlement to six months full pay had expired and an extension of pay at 100% of full pay has been granted for a period of six months or a return to work, whichever is the sooner.
- 5.** In one case the entitlement to six months full pay had expired followed by a further six months of pay at 100% of full pay. An extension of pay at 50% of full pay has been granted for a period of six months or a return to work, whichever is the sooner.



Background *(continued)*

- 6.** In one case the entitlement to six months full pay had expired followed by a further four months of pay at 100% of full pay. An extension of pay at 50% of full pay has been granted for a period of six months or a return to work, whichever is the sooner.
- 7.** In the period under review, two employees are Wholetime and two are Retained members within the Service.
