- On 14<sup>th</sup> April, the Chair and Cllr W P Roberts met with representatives from the Independent Remuneration Panel to discuss remuneration issues for Fire and Rescue Authorities in Wales. The current arrangements for determining allowances are due to change when the proposed Local Government (Wales) Measure is made later this year. The Measure will extend the Panel's powers and remit to include the determination of allowances for members of National Park Authorities and Fire and Rescue Authorities. The Panel was therefore interested in discussing the merits and limitations of the current allowances arrangements and which areas should be subject to review. A similar meeting was held in 2009 with the Chair and Vice-Chair. The outcome of their work is expected later in the year.
- At the WLGA Fire and Rescue Panel meeting, the following issues were discussed: FRS Advisor, Assembly Elections and Ministerial Appointments, Comprehensive Spending Review Commitments and Impacts on FRS; Budgets; Simpson Review; All Wales Members' Development Group.
- Regular update meetings between the Chief Fire Officer, Chair, Vice-Chair and Deputy Chief Fire Officer were held on 15<sup>th</sup> April, 6<sup>th</sup> May, 26<sup>th</sup> May and 17<sup>th</sup> June.
